



The Pioneers Itinerary

Day 1- Silver Spring, MD

We start in Silver Springs, MD. We check into the hotel and dinner on your own.

Day 2- Silver Spring, MD

We will have breakfast, then leave at 9:00 am for our tour of the Seventh Day Adventist Global Headquarters. After our tour we will have lunch at your own cost, then head to our City Tour of D.C.. On the city tour we will visit the U.S. Capitol, the White House, WWII Memorial, the Korean, Lincoln, and Vietnam Veterans Memorials. The tour will also include the Tidal Basin Area, Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial, Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial and the Jefferson Memorial. We will stay overnight in Silver Spring, MD. You are on your own for dinner.

Day 3- New Bedford, MA

We will have breakfast and depart our hotel. Then we will travel to New England. We will stop for lunch along the way and you are on your own for lunch. We should arrive to the New Bedford area around 5:00pm. We will have a short meeting then you will be on your own for dinner.

Day 4- Lowell/Tewksbury MA

We will have breakfast and leave our hotel and drive to the Joseph Bates sites in Fair Haven, MA. We will then make our way to Sturbridge Village: a "must-see" New England attraction which depicts life in an early 19th-century rural Village, featuring costumed historians, antique buildings, water-powered mills, and a working farm. You can view antiques, meet heritage breed animals, and take part in hands-on crafts. Then we will drive to AUC Campus and have a brief tour. Then head to hotel and check in for the night. Dinner will be on your own.

Day 5- Lowell/Tewksbury, MA

We will have breakfast and head to Hazen Foss's Grave, in Haverhill, MA. From there we will travel to Gorham, ME and see Ellen Harmon-Whites girlhood home. We will have a short trip around the quaint city of Portland. We will then visit George Cobb's grave in Brunswick, ME and Stockbridge Howland's home in Topsham, ME. We will then have dinner on your own and check into the hotel for the night.

Day 6- Rutland, VT We will have breakfast and depart the hotel. We will then drive to Leonard Hastings Potato Patch in New Ipswich, NH. Next, we head to Wilton, NH and Annie and Uriah Smith's birthplace. We will then visit Washington Church in Wilton Center, NH. We will then check into our hotel and get dinner on our own.

Day 7- Syracuse, NY

We will have breakfast and depart our hotel. We will head to Lowhampton, NY and see the William Miller Farm. Here we will have our Sabbath Service and Lunch. We will also have our feet washing here. After exploring the farm and our Sabbath activities we will head to the Hotel and have dinner on our own.

Day 8- Rochester, NY We will have breakfast and depart our hotel. We will travel to the SDA Church. Next we head to Hiram Edson's Farm in Port Gibson, NY. We will also see other historic Adventist sites, like Mt Hope Cemetery, the site of the White Home and the site of the Advent Review. Next you have your afternoon free at the Outlets where you are on your own for lunch and dinner. The buses will pick you back up at 8:00pm. We will then head to the hotel for check in.

Day 9- Battle Creek, MI We will have breakfast and depart our hotel to head for Michigan. Lunch and dinner will be on your own while traveling to Michigan. Check into the hotel.

Day 10- Battle Creek MI We will have breakfast and depart our hotel to visit many Adventist historical sites including: Historic Adventist Village, Oak Hill Cemetery, W.K. Kellogg Manor House. We will head back to the hotel and have dinner on your own.

Day 11- Granger IN We will have breakfast and depart and head to Andrews University. Here you will have a tour of the University. Then you will have lunch on your own. After lunch, you will have Seminars from 1:15-5:30. You will have an evening devotional. You will have dinner on your own and head to the hotel for check in.
