The Pioneers Itinerary

Sunday, October 8th- Silver Spring, MD

We start in Silver Springs, MD. We check into the hotel. Dinner is on your own.

Monday, October 9th-Silver Spring, MD

After breakfast, at 9:00 am we have our tour of the Seventh Day Adventist World Church Headquarters. After the educational tour you will have free time for lunch. Next we head to the city tour of Washington D.C. On the city tour we will visit the U.S. Capitol, the White House, WWII Memorial, the Korean, Lincoln, and Vietnam Veterans Memorials. The tour will also include the Tidal Basin Area, Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial, Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial and the Jefferson Memorial. We will stay overnight in Silver Spring, MD. Dinner is on your own.

Tuesday, October 10th- New Bedford, MA

We will have a buffet breakfast at the hotel. Starting our travel day to New England. We will stop for lunch along the way and you are on your own for lunch. We should arrive to the New Bedford area around 5:00pm. We will have a short meeting after you free time for dinner.

Wednesday, October 11th- Lowell/Tewksbury MA

After breakfast at the hotel, we travel to the Joseph Bates home in Fairhaven, MA. Next we will make our way to Sturbridge Village: a "must-see" New England attraction which depicts life in an early 19th-century rural Village, featuring costumed historians, antique buildings, water-powered mills, and a working farm. You can view antiques, meet heritage breed animals, and take part in hands-on crafts. Then we will drive to AUC Campus and have a brief tour. Then head to hotel and check in for the night. You are on your own for dinner.

Thursday, October 12th-Lowell/Tewksbury, MA

We will have breakfast and head to Hazen Foss's Grave, in Haverhill, MA. From there we will travel to Gorham, ME and see Ellen Harmon-Whites girlhood home. Next we have a short trip to the quaint city of Portland. After our city tour we will visit George Cobb's grave in Brunswick, ME and Stockbridge Howland's home in Topsham, ME. We check into the hotel for the night and dinner is on your own.

Friday, October 13th-Rutland, VT

After breakfast, we will then drive to Leonard Hastings Potato Patch in New Ipswich, NH. After the tour of the potato patch we head to Wilton, NH and Annie and Uriah Smith's birthplace. Next we visit Washington Church in Wilton Center, NH. Check into our hotel, dinner on your own.

Saturday, October 14th Syracuse, NY

After breakfast we will head to Lowhampton, NY and visit the William Miller Farm. Here we will have our Sabbath Service and Lunch. We will see Ascension Rock and have foot washing. After exploring the farm and our Sabbath activities we will head to the Hotel and have dinner on your own.

Sunday, October 15th-Rochester, NY

After breakfast at the hotel, we will travel to Roosevelt, NY and visit the SDA Church. Next we go to Hiram Edson's Farm in Port Gibson, NY. We will also see other historic Adventist sites, like Mt Hope Cemetery, the site of the White Home and the site of the Advent Review. After the tours you have your afternoon free at the Outlets where you are on your own for lunch and dinner. The buses will pick you back up at 8:00pm. We will then head to the hotel for check in.

Monday, October 16th-Battle Creek,MI

After breakfast, we head to Michigan. Lunch and dinner will be on your own while traveling to Michigan.

Tuesday, October 17th –Battle Creek MI

We will have breakfast and depart our hotel to visit various Adventist historical sites including: Historic Adventist Village, lunch at the Federal Center Building, Oak Hill Cemetery, W.K. Kellogg Manor House. On our way back to the hotel we will stop and see the BattleCreek Tabernacle Church. Dinner will be on your own.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS: A deposit and completed reservation form are required to secure a reservation for your tour. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent upon our receipt of your deposit of \$250.

MEALS: American buffet breakfast will be provided throughout the tour. If a passenger chooses not to have a meal, there will be no refund for unused meals.

SIGHTSEEING: By modern motor coach including services of English and Spanish speaking guides and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary.

TRAVEL INSURANCE (optional) Is strongly recommended.

Tips to guides, drivers and portage are NOT included (approximately \$8 per day).

PASSPORTS, VISAS: A valid US passport is required for US citizens. If you do not have a Passport please contact your local passport office. Passports must be valid 6 months after return date. For all other nationalities please consult the country's consulate.

TOUR PRICE: Price is based on international tariffs and rates in effect on Date of Proposal. Price is based on a minimum of 40 passengers using double occupancy. In the event that a minimum of passengers does not book the tour within 45 days of departure the agent reserves the right to cancel or re-cost the tour. Late booking or changes may result in an additional fee.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of USD \$250 Non-refundable per person is required to secure reservations, which will be applied to the price of the tour. The balance is to be paid in full not later than 45 days prior to departure of the tour. Thereafter, a USD \$100 late payment fee will be assessed. Reservations made within 30 days of departure are subject to \$75 late reservation charge. All cancellations must be in writing by letter, fax or e-mail to Gospel Travel and will be in effect on the date of receipt by Gospel Travel.

There is no exception to cancellation fee. Any exceptions must be in writing from Gospel Travel. Air penalties are not part of the percentages below and vary based on the airline policy at the time of ticket issue.

International air carriers and other IATA carriers, steamship lines and other transportation companies whose services are featured in these tours are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board their conveyance.

The passage contract in use by these companies when issued shall constitute the sole contract between the companies and the purchaser of these tours and/or passage. The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary, delete or substitute sites when Tour operator feels it to be in the best interest of the tour.

EXCHANGE RATE FLUCTUATIONS:

Foreign currency exchange rates fluctuate daily. For example, in 2008, Euro rates versus the US Dollar fluctuated from a low below 1.25 to almost 1.70 (meaning that one Euro cost \$1.25 to \$1.70 US). It is very difficult to set the price of a tour when we cannot predict what exchange rates will do. We price our tours at a set exchange rate and adjust for fluctuations at final billing. If the rate drops below the original rate, we pass the savings on to our passengers. If rates increase, then we must pass those costs on.
